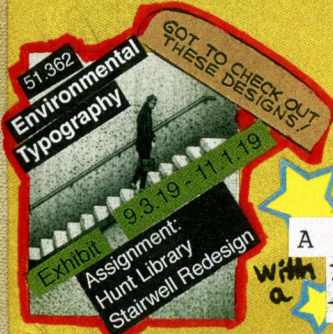

The LIBRARIAN BUN

Essentially, what has been said here adds up to this: College and university librarians must act on an understanding of the fact that their functions are changing. Libraries must now be multipurpose; librarians must be concerned with how information is found, manipulated, assessed, and used to achieve instructional purposes. Libraries are not simply repositories of inert data waiting to be called to service. They must be active, essential cogs in a changing, emerging instructional system. It seems obvious that they have never achieved their full potential. Perhaps their moment has now arrived.

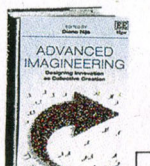

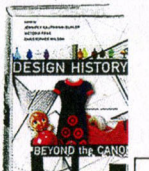
